What information we keep

Name and title, address, email, phone, mobile, emergency contact, how you found us, date joined, groups to which you belong, attendance, choice on magazine delivery, membership paid and when. You can see a copy of all your information by requesting a report from the Membership Secretary.

How we use your information

To maintain a record of your membership, for us and group leaders to contact you about the activities of the branch or groups, and to monitor branch meeting attendance.

How long do we keep your information

For a maximum of 3 years after you leave Heath u3a.

Who we share this with

Committee members who need to use this data, for example those responsible for group coordination, membership and mailings. Contact data of group members is shared with group leaders to allow them to keep group members informed and arrange activities. Address information is shared with the Third Age Trust printers for direct delivery of magazines (if opted-in).

How is your data stored

On a secure database administereed by the Third Age Trust - Beacon - accessible only to committee members.

What you can do.

You can get a copy of the information we hold by contacting the Membership sec.

You can *opt-out* of magazine delivery by informing us.

You can *unsubscribe* from email by informing us or replying to a general email with the message "unsubscribe".
