HEATH U3A LIABILITY

Heath U3A is a volunteer organisation with all its activities led and organised by its members. Volunteers take normal precautions in its activities and provide reasonable help and assistance to our members. However, volunteers do not have control of the environment and cannot therefore accept responsibility for any circumstances affecting the Health and Safety of members. **The following should be noted:**

Membership of, and payment of a subscription to, Heath U3A does not imply any liability for the Health and Safety of its members on the part of Heath U3A.

Outdoor activities organised by Heath U3A groups automatically receive **Public Liability insurance** cover through the **Third Age Trust**, provided the leaders are U3A members. This is designed to protect leaders against damage to property and for injury or death which might have been occasioned during the activity. This is **NOT** a personal accident insurance and accordingly participants in Heath U3A activities are responsible for their own Health and Safety and the safe keeping of their belongings.

Participants in group activities should follow common sense in order to minimise any risk to themselves and should also ensure that they do not endanger any others in the group.

Heath U3A activities do not normally include children or dogs. Members who wish to bring visitors, children or their dog on a Heath U3A activity must ask for permission from the Group Leader/Organiser.
