

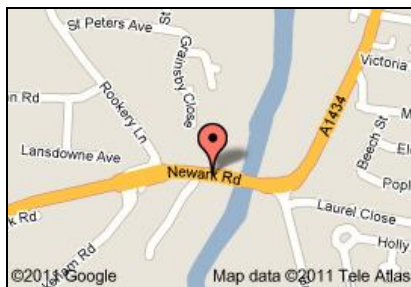
## Heath U3A Lincoln – Future strolling venues.

A Lincoln pub in the Bracebridge situated on a busy main road into Lincoln and sitting alongside the River Witham. Dating to pre 1875, although rebuilt and extended in 1976, it is probable that this was originally both a farmhouse and village inn at the same time.

Out stroll takes us along the River Witham paths.

Dunston is a small village, 9 miles south east of Lincoln England, with a population of about 700. Around 1100 A.D., the village was called Dunestune and means Dunn's farmstead or village. It is twinned with a similar sized village, Trange, near Le Mans, Sarthe, France and has an active twinning association.
